The two phases include the Academic RAMP program, which include refresher courses on Math and English and the Indoctrination / Orientation Period (IOP), which include regimental activities designed to instill discipline, develop your stamina as well as other desirable attitudes to the unique educational system of MAAP.

We advise you to prepare physically, mentally and emotionally for this last screening process. At the end of the Academic Ramp and IOP, you are expected to run three (3) kilometers in <u>18</u> minutes, do <u>30</u> push-ups, <u>35</u> sit-ups and <u>6</u> pull-ups. Your physical fitness will significantly increase your ability to adjust to Academy life. Academically, your skills in Math and English will help in coping with the rigors of academics.

We do encourage you to have complete or at least first dose of vaccination / immunization on MMR (Mumps, Measles, Rubella vaccine) and Chickenpox prior to reporting at MAAP. We also recommend bringing with you multivitamins good for two (2) months.

In addition, Academy regulations do not allow possession of jewelry items such as necklace, earring, ring, wristwatch, bracelet and other vanity items as well as any kind of communication / electronics equipment (cellphone, two-way radio, pager, etc.). Hence do not bring these items to avoid getting in trouble from the start.

On the other hand, please be informed that the following measures will be implemented upon reporting at MAAP Campus:

- 1) Only applicant is allowed to enter MAAP premises.
- 2) Applicant will undergo thermal body scanning/temperature checking. Anyone found to have a temperature of 37.8 degrees Celsius and above including those with cough and colds will not be allowed to enter the MAAP premises and will be advised to seek medical attention.
- 3) Wear your face mask and face shield at all times while inside MAAP premises.
- 4) Observe a distance of at least 1.5 meter away from other individuals.

As part of our Health and Safety Protocols, we will limit the access inside the Academy grounds for the applicants only. Parents will be denied entry to avoid congestion and violating the physical distancing measure.
