

MAAP MIDSHIPMEN DOMINATES TOMSP 2017

Rosal's Project Proposal Awarded Best Among 20 Finalists



2 Midshipmen and 2 Midshipwomen from MAAP were awarded together with 6 other maritime students as Ten Outstanding Maritime Students of the Philippines 2017 in Cuneta Astrodome last 24th of September 2017.



Midn Patrick Allan Peralta 1CL of Iriga City and Midn Karl Japeth Rosal 1CL of General Santos City are both sponsored by International Maritime Employers Council residing at the CGSO Campus. Both Midn Peralta and Midn Rosal are under Bernard Schulte Ship Management. Also,

Midn Rosal's Gravity Lamp Proposal was awarded the best among those submitted by the 20 finalists.

Midwn Loren Negapatan 2cl of Polomolok, South Cotabato and Midwn Nellyvette Claire Dela Cruz 2cl of Bacolod City are under AP Moller – Mærsk and among the 4 female awardees this year, the most number within 1 season of TOMSP since its establishment.

In line with the said search, Dr Conrado Oca, the Chairman of MAAP's Governing Board, was cited by the Alumni as an exemplar and inspiration to the Young Transport Workers of the country.

The TOMSP is an annual search for the best maritime students in the country in Academics, Extra Curricular and Leadership Engagement, and Service to their Community and family. The selection of top 20 this year was done via paper screening of the nominees credential and the 10 awardees this year was selected after the Technical Panel Interview, Leadership and Social Responsibility Panel Interview, Written Examination, and an On the Spot Essay Writing. Each of the 10 Awardees received a Plaque and P15 000.00 courtesy of Western Union, Licensure Exam Scholarship after their graduation provided by Cebu Gems Innovation and Career Development Center worth P37 500.00, and commemorative paraphernalia in silver crafted by Santi Enterprises. All 20 finalists were covered with P50 000 worth of accident insurance by SunLife of Canada, and received gifts from AMOSUP and Smart Communications.
